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1 MS. BETH KERN: It is 6:00 p.m. We'll go
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- 2 ahead and call this meeting to order. I am the
- 3 solicitor for the Spring Grove Borough Zoning Hearing
- 4 Board. And we'll start this evening's meeting with a
- 5 pledge to the flag.
- 6 (Pledge of Allegiance).
- 7 MS. BETH KERN: For roll call, we have
- 8 two of the three members of the Zoning Hearing Board
- 9 present here this evening. Would you just introduce
- 10 yourselves, first and last name, to those here in
- 11 attendance to the meeting.
- 12 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Sure. My name is
- 13 Kristyn Stouch.
- 14 MR. JAROD MARTIN: My name is Jarod
- 15 Martin.
- 16 MS. BETH KERN: And for the applicants
- 17 that are here this evening for your application, so the
- 18 Zoning Hearing Board is a three-member body which is a
- 19 quasi-judicial body. They're here to hear your
- 20 application and make a decision this evening.
- 21 Unfortunately, the third member of the
- 22 board was unable to attend. So since there are two
- 23 members of the board here this evening, we want to make
- 24 you aware that in the event of a tie vote regarding
- 25 whether to approve or deny your application, that would

1 result procedurally in a denial of your application,

- 2 which you would have a legal right to appeal.
- 3 Understanding that, can you please
- 4 acknowledge that you understand that that could be the
- 5 outcome? Can you state your name and then indicate yes
- 6 or no for the stenographer, please?
- 7 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: I, Kaylee Flemmens,
- 8 yes, understand.
- 9 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: I, Zachary
- 10 Flemmens, also understand.
- 11 MS. BETH KERN: Okay. Thank you very
- 12 much. All right. We're going to hold on public
- 13 comments until during the new business item. If anyone
- 14 is here that has comment or would like to give
- 15 testimony, you'll be given an opportunity to do that
- 16 during the new business item.
- 17 So then we're going to move on to the
- 18 reorganization of the Zoning Hearing Board. Since this
- 19 is the first meeting of 2025 in which the Board is
- 20 coming together, I'll ask for a nomination for a
- 21 chairperson of the Zoning Hearing Board.
- 22 MR. JAROD MARTIN: I nominate Kristyn
- 23 Stouch to be the chairperson.
- 24 MS. BETH KERN: All right, all in favor
- 25 of that nomination?

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1 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Aye.
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- 2 MR. JAROD MARTIN: Aye.
- 3 MS. BETH KERN: Opposed?
- 4 (No opposition.)
- 5 MS. BETH KERN: Kristyn is the
- 6 chairperson of the Board. So now you'll want to call
- 7 for a nomination of a Vice Chair, or you can nominate.
- 8 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: I'll nominate Jarod
- 9 as Vice Chair.
- 10 MS. BETH KERN: All those in favor?
- 11 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Aye.
- MR. JAROD MARTIN: Aye.
- 13 MS. BETH KERN: So now you can proceed
- 14 with calling the new business item. So you can go ahead
- 15 and read what item one is.
- 16 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Item 1 is
- 17 ZHB-01-2025-213 Glenview Road, Spring Grove,
- 18 Pennsylvania 17362. Kaylee and Zachary Flemmens to be
- 19 considered for a variance to allow a 5-foot fence in
- 20 what is considered their front yard due to being on a
- 21 corner lot.
- 22 MS. BETH KERN: All right, so if the
- 23 applicants could please come up to the podium to present
- 24 your application. We're also going to need to get you
- 25 sworn in.

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1 KAYLEE FLEMMENS AND ZACHARY FLEMMENS,
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- were called as witnesses, being duly sworn,
- 3 testified as follows:
- 4 MS. BETH KERN: And also the Zoning
- 5 Officer present this evening, Danielle Robison. Would
- 6 you also please swear in the Zoning Officer?
- 7 DANIELLE ROBISON, being duly sworn,
- 8 testified as follows:
- 9 MS. BETH KERN: Before the applicants
- 10 proceed, do you have any information to share regarding
- 11 this application or property of interest for the Board's
- 12 attention this evening?
- 13 MS. DANIELLE ROBISON: Sure. So the
- 14 property is on the corner lot here. This is their
- 15 garage and a little driveway. They're just wanting to
- 16 put the fence right on the back at the end of the garage
- 17 and go back. Unfortunately because of our ordinances,
- 18 we have to have the variance because it is considered
- 19 their front yard and they're only allowed by ordinance
- 20 to have a three-foot fence.
- 21 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: But your address is
- 22 Glenview, right?
- MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: Yes.
- 24 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: And your mailbox is
- 25 on Glenview?

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1 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: No, it is not.
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- 2 It's actually on Hamlet.
- 3 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Okay, I understand.
- 4 MS. BETH KERN: And was there public
- 5 notice given for this hearing this evening?
- 6 MS. DANIELLE ROBISON: Correct.
- 7 MS. BETH KERN: And was the property
- 8 posted in advance?
- 9 MS. DANIELLE ROBISON: Yes, ma'am.
- 10 MS. BETH KERN: Okay. Thank you. All
- 11 right, if you could, one of you just one at a time, if
- 12 you could explain to the board in just a little bit more
- 13 detail what you're proposing about the fence, if it will
- 14 be five-foot in the entire perimeter or if it's only in
- 15 certain sections just so they can better understand what
- 16 you're asking for this evening.
- 17 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: We're just
- 18 proposing to have a five-foot fence the whole way around
- 19 the back yard, our back yard, because three-foot does
- 20 not suffice for our two large dogs and children. We're
- 21 keeping it 25 feet from the curb, which is the said
- 22 setback.
- 23 MS. BETH KERN: What material will the
- 24 fence be made out of?
- 25 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: Vinyl.

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1 MS. BETH KERN: Are there any other
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- 2 fences similar in the neighborhood where your property
- 3 is located?
- 4 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: Yes.
- 5 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: Our neighbors right
- 6 beside us have a wooden. So I don't know if it's five
- 7 or six-foot.
- 8 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: There's also
- 9 corner lots that also have beyond the flush point or
- 10 whatever you want to call it.
- 11 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: There's some other
- 12 fences in the neighborhood that are on corner lots that
- 13 are higher than the three-foot ordinance. There's heavy
- 14 foot traffic and car traffic at the turn there. And
- 15 there's heavy foot traffic with lots of pets and I don't
- 16 think three-foot is going to contain if somebody wants
- 17 to get in or out, a child or a kid on either side.
- 18 MS. BETH KERN: And according to your
- 19 diagram in your application, is it also accurate that
- 20 the fence will connect to your house on either side to
- 21 the rear of the home?
- MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: Yes.
- 23 MS. BETH KERN: And that portion of the
- 24 fence would also be five feet tall; is that correct?
- 25 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: Yes. Same thing

- 1 all the way from side to side.
- 2 MS. BETH KERN: You recently purchased
- 3 this property; is that correct?
- 4 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: Correct.
- 5 MR. ZACHARY FLEMMENS: Six months ago.
- 6 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: October 11th of
- 7 2024.
- 8 MS. BETH KERN: In 2024. And you didn't
- 9 create the corner lot condition, it was that way when
- 10 you purchased it; is that right?
- 11 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: Right.
- 12 MS. BETH KERN: I'm just asking you
- 13 questions just to help get some information on the
- 14 record that's helpful for the Board in deciding your
- 15 application. Okay?
- 16 Do either of the board members have any
- 17 questions for the applicants?
- 18 MR. JAROD MARTIN: No.
- 19 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: No.
- 20 MS. BETH KERN: Does anyone from the
- 21 public who's here have any questions for the applicant?
- 22 MEETING ATTENDANT: We're just here in
- 23 support.
- 24 MS. KAYLEE FLEMMENS: These are our old
- 25 neighbors. We lived out on 85 Roth's Church Road before

1 we moved in here. So those are our old neighbors, James

- 2 and Erica. And this is Victoria and Richard that live
- 3 right behind us right now, 503 Hamlet.
- 4 MR. RICHARD MATHIAS: Richard and
- 5 Victoria Mathias. We're the Flemmens' nextdoor
- 6 neighbor. Our back yard and their back yard meet and
- 7 we're in favor of their fence.
- 8 MS. BETH KERN: Okay. Thank you. Is
- 9 there anyone else that would like to make any particular
- 10 comment either in support or opposition or provide any
- 11 testimony relative to the application? It's okay if you
- 12 don't.
- 13 MR. JAMES STERNER: As former neighbors
- 14 of Zach and Kaylee --
- 15 MS. BETH KERN: Could you just state your
- 16 name, sir?
- 17 MR. JAMES STERNER: Absolutely. James
- 18 Sterner. As former neighbors, I would offer support.
- 19 We live on the other end of the neighborhood. We
- 20 regularly walk through where they live. Feel that it
- 21 would not detract from the neighborhood. Zach and
- 22 Kaylee maintain their property very well and with a
- 23 growing family and the neighborhood being supportive of
- 24 families and pets, we would be in support of them having
- 25 such a fence in our neighborhood.

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1 MS. BETH KERN: All right. Thank you.
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- 2 James and Richard, since you both kind of have given
- 3 some comments that have drifted into testimony, I think
- 4 it would be best if you could just please be sworn by
- 5 the stenographer here regarding your statements. I know
- 6 this all seems to be a little bit of overkill, but we
- 7 want to make sure we have the procedures in the record
- 8 correct for tonight.
- 9 RICHARD MATHIAS and JAMES STERNER, were
- 10 duly sworn as witnesses and testified as recorded.
- 11 MS. BETH KERN: All right. Well, if the
- 12 Board doesn't have any other questions and there's no
- 13 one else present with any comments or questions, would
- 14 you like to entertain a motion or make a motion?
- 15 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Yes. I would like
- 16 to make a motion to approve their five-foot fence.
- 17 MS. BETH KERN: To approve the variance
- 18 as requested.
- 19 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: To approve the
- 20 variance as requested.
- 21 MR. JAROD MARTIN: Second.
- 22 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: All those in favor
- 23 say "Aye."
- MR. JAROD MARTIN: Aye.
- 25 MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: Aye. Those opposed?

3	approved.	There's no other business so you can call for
4	adjournmen	t.
5		MS. KRISTYN STOUCH: This meeting is
6	adjourned.
